LAST TIME OUT - GREENJACKETS 9, RIVERDOGS 8

Despite a 4-hit, 5-RBI performance from Brody Donay, the RiverDogs fell short against Augusta, 9-8 on Saturday night at Joseph P. Riley, Jr. Park... The RiverDogs out-hit Augusta 13-11... A five-run fourth inning for the GreenJackets put them in command of the contest... Jose Urbina struck out six in 2.1 innings but surrendered 3 runs (2 ER)... Narciso Polanco finished the game 4-5... Donay capped his big night with a 3-run ninth inning homer that cut the deficit to 9-8, but Jackson Dannelley retired the next batter to end the game...

SO LONG FROM THE JOE

The RiverDogs wrap up the 2025 home schedule with this evening's contest. Entering today, the RiverDogs have the most home wins in the Carolina League (38). Charleston has posted a winning record at home in six straight seasons.

DONAY'S DARN GOOD NIGHT

Brody Donay set a new single-game high for RBIs by a RiverDog, racking up five in Saturday night's loss. Donay's four-hit performance marked the ninth time this season a RiverDog collected four or more hits. His ninth-inning home run - his first as a pro - traveled 428 feet.

UNLUCKY 13

The RiverDogs tied their season high for hits in a losing effort last night with 13. The loss marked the second time in a week the RiverDogs racked up 13 hits in a game and still lost (8/24 at Myrtle Beach).

HITS ON HITS

After 10 hits from Augusta last night, the RiverDogs have surrendered 10+ hits in 15 games this month. The RiverDogs are 1-14 in those games. In that same span, the RiverDogs have had 10+ hits in just five games.

HOME SWEET HOME

The RiverDogs locked up a series victory in their final homestand of the year with Thursday night's win. Of their 12 home series this season, the RiverDogs have won eight of them, split one and lost three (all to Myrtle Beach). The RiverDogs' 3.24 home ERA is third-best in Single-A this season and second in the Carolina League.

STAYING UP LATE

Of their 28 runs scored this week, 18 of the RiverDogs' tallies have come in the sixth inning or later, three ninth inning runs last night.

ANGRY AUGUST

The month of August has not been kind to the RiverDogs. Charleston's .618 OPS is second-lowest in the league this month. On the mound, their 5.00 ERA and .273 BAA are league worsts.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR...

Myrtle Beach clinched the Carolina League second half title with a win Thursday night, officially eliminating the RiverDogs from playoff contention. The 'Dogs missed out on a playoff spot by one game in the first half. This season marks the first time the RiverDogs have missed the postseason since joining the Carolina League for the 2021 season. Despite missing out on the postseason, the RiverDogs trail Myrtle Beach by one game for the best record in the Carolina League South. Since 2018, every team that has posted the best overall record in their respective division has made the Carolina League postseason.

NEED SAVING?

The RiverDogs have converted save opportunities in all four wins this week against Augusta. Charleston's bullpen has nailed down 35 saves this season, tied for the most in the league and second in Single-A. The RiverDogs bullpen leads Single-A with 49 holds.

SIX IS THE NUMBER

Charleston is 5-34 when allowing six or more runs this season. When scoring six or more, the RiverDogs are 32-5. Last night's loss marks just the second time this season the RiverDogs scored seven runs or more and lost (15-2).

LONGING FOR THE LONGBALL

With homers from Brailer Guerrero and Brody Donay last night, the RiverDogs picked up their eighth team multi-homer game of the season and just their second in the second half. The RiverDogs' 39 home runs are tied for the fewest in Minor League Baseball (Lynchburg). The RiverDogs are on pace to hit their fewest home runs in a season since 2015 (46).

TWIN KILLERS

The RiverDogs lead the league with 106 double plays turned this season, but also lead the league in GDP (81).

SCOUTING REPORT

Works with a four pitch mix: Fastball (92-94), Slider (mid-80s), Curve (12-6, low-80s), Changeup (mid-80s).

Baseball America Draft Report: “Andrade is a 6-foot-2 righthander with a lean frame and wide shoulders that suggest more strength gains on the way... Andrade has a solid three-pitch mix that includes a 92-94 mph fastball that has touched 96, a mid-80s slider and a mid-80s changeup. All three have the potential to be quality pitches, but Andrade needs to improve his feel to land them both for strikes and command them in the zone.”

SEASON NOTES

LAST START: Allowed season-high 6 ER on 9 hits in 5 innings on 8/24 at Myrtle Beach... Five of the six runs came in the 2nd inning...

HE’S A WINNER: Ryan Andrade is the 12th RiverDog to post a 10-win season since 2005 and just the fourth since the team re-affiliated with the Rays for the 2021 season... List includes big leaguers David Phelps ('09) and Roansy Contreras ('19)

HIGH QUALITY: Andrade has chucked nine quality starts - the most Single-A.

JOE SWEET JOE: Has posted a 1.42 ERA in 57 innings at home this season... 4.76 ERA in 51 IP on the road.

NOTHING’S FREE: Has posted a 3.6 BB/9 rate this season... Lowest mark in college was 6.1 BB/9 last season with Pitt...

LEADERBOARDS: Ranks 3rd in the Carolina League in ERA (3.00), 4th in BAA (.231), 4th in WHIP (1.25) and 2nd in innings pitched (108.0).

ABOUT RYAN

ORIGIN STORY: Drafted by the Rays in the 7th round of the 2024 Draft out of Pitt... Pitched first two college seasons in his home state of Rhode Island before transferring to Pitt for a season...

WHAT THEY’RE SAYING: Rays amateur scouting director Chuck Ricci (after the draft): “He has a very loose, live, athletic arm... He can really spin the ball. He needs to add strength and consistency.”

NEW SCHOOL, NEW ROLE: After pitching his first two college seasons out of the bullpen at Rhode Island, primarily as a closer, Pitt moved Andrade to the rotation. As the Panthers' Friday night starter, Andrade posted a 7.86 ERA in 63 innings... Led the Panthers in strikeouts in 2024 with 72 across his 15 starts... Former Big League catcher and Pitt HC Devin Mesoraco would often catch bullpens... Added Slider and Changeup after moving to Pitt...

IN MY FREE TIME: Andrade may be the best golfer on the RiverDogs roster, boasting a near-scratch handicap.

TWINS!: Has a twin brother, Patrick, who is a Firefighter... Also has two sisters, Molly and Deveny...

COACHING STAFF

Sean Smedley

Manager

Sean Smedley is back for his ninth season with the Rays and third season as Manager of the RiverDogs. Smedley led the team to complete the three-peat as Carolina League Champions in 2023, as well as the South Division second half title in 2024. During his playing career, he was a part of the Rays system in Bowling Green and Hudson Valley, and in 2016 he began his coaching career within the same organization he played for as video coordinator for the Princeton Rays. From 2017-2019, he was the bench coach for Hudson Valley. In 2021, after the Covid-19 pandemic, he became the bench coach for the RiverDogs. Smedley helped guide the RiverDogs to a dominant 82-38 campaign where they would eventually secure their inaugural title. He left to become a bench coach for Double-A Montgomery in 2022 and returned to the Lowcountry the following year.

Brett Schneider

Hitting Coach

Brett Schneider returns to the Holy City for a second season as the hitting coach of the RiverDogs. The bats saw massive improvements throughout 2024 and finished third in the league in walks and fourth in on-base percentage. Schneider spent the previous four years as a hitting coach in the Seattle Mariners farm system, including with the Arizona Complex League Mariners in 2023. Prior to coaching in the professional ranks, Schneider was a volunteer assistant coach at Florida Atlantic University. Pitching Coach
